



Fantasy Football

Task:

You are the **star player** on your school's football team giving an interview following the biggest game of the season.

As the star player your job is to write a script thanking your coach, team members, and the fans for their support throughout the football season.

As the **news reporter** at this event you must ask the star player questions following the big win.

Examples:

1. What was your objective coming into the game?
-To establish our running game , keep turnovers to a minimum, and to minimize penalties
2. What type of adjustments did the defense have to make in the second half to stop the passing attack?
-We sent more blitz packages at the quarterback to keep him thrown off and we couldn't allow him to get into a passing rhythm
3. How important was it to establish the running game going into the second half?
- It was very important because the running game sets the tempo for the passing attack



Process:

You and your partner will work together to determine your role then write a script.

1. Determine which of you will be the player and who will be the news reporter
 - a. Football player- your role is to be the face of your webcam project as you give thanks to those who have supported you and the team and as you announce your intentions for the following season
 - b. News reporter- your role is to ask the football player at least 2 follow up questions about the game and/or future plans
2. Use the following sports websites to locate sports news

3. Your team will write your script and follow up questions for the webcam project
4. Open Newsmaker software
5. Follow the wizard by filling in each section (enter a project name, create new story, enter a story title and author's name, use the story editor to enter your story's text, click next)
6. Choose Settings: decide on your Display Information (story title, news reader, subtitle, date, multimedia)
7. Choose your Face-Tracking Effects:
For your press conference be certain to include
 - a. Football headgear
 - b. Press Conference frame (microphones)
 - c. Any other effects your team decides
8. Ball Player will give 30 second speech
9. Reporter will follow up with 2 questions
10. Ball Player will answer the 2 questions
11. Record your video
12. Choose next for your video list
13. Use the move up, move down, insert, transition, and delete tools to finalize your project
14. Click publish to save your video to the desktop
15. It saves as a .wmv
