QSM Grant

The Quality Science and Math Grant Program (QSM) was established by the Louisiana Legislature in 1992 for the purpose of providing materials and equipment to mathematics and science public school teachers. Only full-time public school teachers assigned to teach mathematics or science in regular K-12 education programs are eligible to apply for QSM grants of up \$750. Grant funds must be used for the purchase of non-consumable instructional equipment and/or materials/education technology. Application deadline is usually in early September.
