BB101:

Introduction to Using Blackboard as a Classroom Website (Orientation Session, Online)

Prerequisite: None

Technology Requirements: Internet Access at Home

CLUs/Tech Points: 6

The hands-on workshop combined with a 4-week online course will guide the teacher through the creation of the Blackboard Classroom Website. Participants will learn how to customize the design of Blackboard, add documents, and utilize Blackboard tools.

BB102:

Move Forward with Your Blackboard Site (Online)

Prerequisite: None

CLUs/Tech Points: 4

The hands-on workshop (orientation session) combined with a 2-week online will guide the teacher through the creation of a classroom portal of the Blackboard Classroom. Participants will learn how to develop content folders, add interactive activities, add voice to announcements, and embedding table and other tools with HTML code.

BB103:

Utilizing Blackboard with Your Faculty or Department (Face-to-Face)

Prerequisite: None

CLUs/Tech Points: 5

This hands-on workshop will introduce principals and their team of 2 teachers to the many features of Blackboard. Participants will learn how to utilize Blackboard tools in the creation of a collaborative environment for their faculty and staff.

BB106:

Orientation to the Content System (Face-to-Face)

Prerequisite: None

CLUs/Tech Points: 2

This hands-on workshop will guide participants through the use the BB content system as a virtual hard drive with file storage for personal use and course content.

BB201:

Utilizing Blackboard to Support Curriculum – Getting Students Involved (Orientation Session, Online)

Prerequisite: BB101, BB102 or BB104

Technology Requirements: Internet Access at Home/ Computer Proficient

CLUs/Tech Points: 8

This hands-on workshop combined with a 3-week online class will guide participants through the enhancement of their current Blackboard Website to utilize with students during the upcoming school year. Participants will learn how to utilize the many tools of Blackboard to create a rich, engaging online environment for students extending instruction beyond the classroom. This class will allow students to have usernames and passwords to Blackboard.

BB202:

Energize or Revive Your Blackboard School Site (Face-to-Face)

Prerequisite: BB103

CLUs/Tech Points: 2

This hands-on workshop will focus on updates and new tools within Blackboard. Come ready to gain new ideas for creating a collaborative online environment for your school faculty & staff.



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BB301:

Using Blackboard for Student Engagement and Assessment (3 Weeks Online)

Prerequisite: BB201

CLUs/Tech Points: 6

In this course, you will explore additional tools in Blackboard that can be used to engage student learning and assess student mastery. The tools include blogs, wikis, rubrics, and YouTube.

BB302:

Using Blackboard Assessment Tools (Face-to-Face)

Prerequisite: BB103 or BB201

CLUs/Tech Points: 2

This hands-on workshop is for department staff, school administrators and teachers who already have experience using Blackboard's basic functions and want to learn more about utilizing Blackboard tools to collect data within their school or department. Topics covered will include: Tests, Surveys, Course Statistics, and Performance Dashboard.

BB304:

Creating ePortfolios in Blackboard (Face-to-Face)

Prerequisite: BB103 or BB201

CLUs/Tech Points: 2

This hands-on workshop will guide teachers through steps to set up and use the portfolio tools to collect data, assess student performance and showcase student work.

BB305:

Podcasting in the Classroom (Face-to-Face)

Prerequisite: BB103 or BB201

CLUs/Tech Points: 2

This hands-on workshop will guide participants through the steps to set up a podcast and produce their first episode within Blackboard.

BB308a:

Using Web 2.0 Tools in the Classroom (Gr. 3-5) (Online Only)

Prerequisite: BB103 or BB201

Technology Requirements: Internet Access at Home/ Computer Proficient

CLUs/Tech Points: 8

This hands-on workshop combined with a 4-week online class will guide participants through the use of blogs, wikis, and podcasts within their Blackboard Website.

BB308b:

Web 2.0 Tools in the Classroom (Gr. 6-8) (Online Only)

Prerequisite: None

Technology Requirements: Internet Access at Home/ Computer Proficient
