## ACT Sub-scores and 4-Year Louisiana Public University Admissions

Did you know that
beginning fall 2014
ACT sub-scores will
help to determine if a
student may gain
admission to a four-
year public Louisiana
university?

All colleges and universities require minimum ACT composite scores for admissions. However, it is important to understand that a minimum ACT English AND Math sub-score is required for a student to qualify for college level coursework at a four-year public institution in Louisiana. Students who do not meet the minimum English AND Math ACT sub-score requirement will require developmental coursework, therefore making them ineligible for admission.

$\Rightarrow$ Universitiescan mix and match ACTcomposite and sub-scores from multiple tests to determine whether an a pplic ant meets the admission requirements.
$\Rightarrow$ Eligibility is based on the highest ACTcomposite and sub-scores.

## Students who do not meet ACTsub-score requirements can:

$\Rightarrow$ Retake the ACTtest
$\Rightarrow$ Enroll in dual-enrollment courses at a local community college to complete developmental coursework.
$\Rightarrow$ Attend a community college after high school until eligible to transfer to a 4-year Louisia na institution by suc cessfully fulfilling transfer a dmissions requirements.
