



Quick Tips

1. Go to www.cpsb.org > Parents and Students > Digital Media Resources > NetTrekker.
2. After you login, click on the correct tab for your grade (elementary, middle, or high).

Keyword Search:

Type your topic in the *Keyword* blank and click on *Search*.

Advanced Search:

Click on the *Advanced Search* link. This enables you to search based on content type (multimedia), website source, language, and location in the netTrekker d.i. directory. Refine your search anytime by clicking *Advanced Search*, located at the top of the page.

Subject Search:

Information from nerTrekker d.i. is organized by school subject. Narrow your search by drillind down through subjects, topics and subtopics that best describe what you are looking for.

Refinement Tool:

When search results contain websites that have more than one form of content, netTrekker d.i. provides dropdown menus at the top of the page so that you can refine your results by choosing one or more of the available options.

Timeline:

The Timeline feature provides a chronological index of eras, events, arts and innovations, and famous people throughout history.

Famous Person Search:

Quickly and easily locate information about well-known people, including political leaders, athletes, scientists, artist, writers and more.

Image Search:

The image search tool provides a quick and easy list of results that corresponds to your specific search. Accessing these images also enables you to locate important information on your topic of interest.
