### Testing Schedule

#### CCR Students

- Arrive by 8AM
  - 8<sup>th</sup> – Enter thru the main doors near front office
  - 7<sup>th</sup>- Enter thru the back gate near the seventh grade building from 20<sup>th</sup> Street.
  - 6<sup>th</sup> - Enter thru the back gate near the sixth grade pods from 20<sup>th</sup> Street.
- Look for hall monitors to provide testing room assignments
- Lunch will be provided for testers from 12:08 - 12:38 M-F.
- Mon - Wed testing will end at about 12:00.
- Thur - Fri testing will end at about 2:30.

#### Face-to-Face Students

- Arrive on time as usual
- Verify testing room with homeroom teacher.
- Avoid being absent
- Continue to regular classes when dismissed from testing room.

OPM students, virtual and on campus, are expected to take the LEAP 2025 state assessment this school year. Please review the following information to determine your testing dates and times to ensure your student is available for all five days of testing. It is important to be in attendance, well rested, and to eat a healthy breakfast before each testing day.

- ❖ **8<sup>th</sup> grade** students: April 26 – April 30
- ❖ **7<sup>th</sup> grade** students: May 03 - May 07
- ❖ **6<sup>th</sup> grade** students: May 10 – May 14
- ❖ **ALL grades make-up sessions:** May 17 – May 21 and/or on Mon – Wed after lunch during assigned grade level week. NOTE: Space is very limited in make-up sessions. Please make arrangements to be present during regularly scheduled testing times.

#### Important Notes:

- If **transportation** was requested on the CCR survey, bus drivers will call to verify transportation.
- Students **must wear a mask** upon entering the building and throughout the time inside the building.
- Students should be dressed appropriately in accordance with CPSB **dress code** policy: no inappropriate words on clothing.
- Students are expected to **behave** in accordance with the CPSB Code of Conduct.
- Students will **NOT have access to personal electronic devices** including cell phones and smart watches during testing as per state guidelines.
- Breakfast (please arrive before 8am) and lunch from the school cafeteria will be available. Please contact the cafeteria manager if there is a food allergy.
- Students must have their student log-ins and passwords in order to log into computers and take exams.
- CCR students may be dismissed once ALL testers in hallway have been dismissed to regular class schedules.
