What is Immersion?

Language Immersion is a method of instruction that produces a high degree of proficiency in the second language (French or Spanish). In the pathway, content knowledge in Math, Science, and Social Studies and language skills are acquired together. Students are not expected to have any prior knowledge of the immersion language before beginning in Kindergarten.

Why Immersion?

Studies show that students in immersion pathways become better problem-solvers and more resilient learners. Learning in a second language increases vocabulary and strengthens grammar in both languages. In addition, students in immersion pathways tend to outscore non-immersion students on standardized tests.

Admission Process:

The school will contact you to start the screening process. If needed, students selected for an Immersion pathway will be granted an Out of Zone permit to attend the Immersion school; however, parents must provide transportation. Once selected for the program, an Out of Zone application must be submitted to Child Welfare and Attendance before June 2021 for admission in August 2021. If your child is not selected for your first school of choice, please apply at another school.
