



Advanced English I

Advanced classes are meant to prepare high school students for Advanced Placement classes, or college-level classes taken in high school. Advanced English students study the same major topics as a regular English class but the lessons are taught at a faster pace to prepare students for college-level classes.

Advanced English students can expect to be held accountable for their learning while reading and analyzing complex texts. Students will practice critical thinking skills and engage in collegiate-level discussions.

Prospective 2021-2020 Advanced English I students should complete the Application by May 14, 2021.

- Upon completion of the application, students will receive access to the summer assignment.
- Students should use their own cpsb.org email account to complete the application.
- Instructions for the Summer Assignment will be available once the application has been submitted.

Prospective 2021-2022 Advanced English I students must complete the Summer Assignment by the first week of school.

Frequently Asked Questions:

1. How will I know if I make it into the class?

After completing the application, your name will be given to our guidance counselors for further review. You will receive your schedule during orientation at the beginning of August.

2. Is it for a grade?

Yes. You will be expected to participate in discussions on the summer reading assignment during the first few weeks of school, and this work will be graded. Completing the assignment will prepare students for the rigor of an advanced class.

3. Is this a group project?

No. This is an individual assignment. Students are expected to complete the reading assignment as preparation for the course.

4. What happens if I don't read the book/complete the assignment?

As an applicant for Advanced English I, you are expected to complete the reading assignment by the first week of school. Failure to do so will result in placement in a regular English class.
