This Notice is for all Parents/Legal Guardians of 10th grade students who will be entering the eleventh-grade next school year.

According to Calcasieu Parish School System policy, your child's immunizations must be up to date to enroll in the school system. The Louisiana Department of Health has recently updated the immunization requirements for school entry.

Beginning with the 2019/2020 school year and continuing thereafter and according to state law, a student shall provide satisfactory evidence of current immunizations against meningococcal disease, and any other age-appropriate vaccines, as a condition of entry into the 11th grade.

Further, any student enrolled into the Calcasieu Parish School System for the first time that has attained the age of 16 years and is entering a grade other than eleventh grade, shall provide satisfactory evidence of current immunizations against meningococcal disease as a condition of school entry.

At the time of registration, students must show proof of immunization of the following age-appropriate vaccines: Tetanus Diphtheria Acellular Pertussis vaccine (Tdap); two (2) doses of Varicella vaccine; two (2) Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR) vaccines; three (3) Hepatitis B (HBV) vaccines; two (2) Meningococcal vaccine (MCV4); and two (2) Hep A vaccines.

Please attend to this over the summer so there will be no interruption in your child's education during the 2023/2024 school year.

Note: Students may participate in school without the required immunizations listed above if a written statement of exemption is presented by a physician, the individual, or the individual's parent/guardian.
