



Justin Demary Memorial Scholarship



The Justin Demary Memorial Scholarship will be awarded to a Southwest Louisiana graduating senior who participates in athletics and personifies the following qualities of character that defined Justin's life:

- Humble Leadership – leading with actions not words
- Resilience – fighting through adversity with a positive can-do attitude
- Intellect – committed to intellectual growth and lifelong learning
- Tenacity – determined and goal oriented

Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible to receive the Justin Demary Memorial Scholarship, a student must meet the following requirements:

- Applicant must be a graduating senior from a Southwest Louisiana school in the 5-parish area: Calcasieu, Cameron, Jeff Davis, Allen, Beauregard.
- Applicant must be student-athlete who is a current/former member in good standing of a school sponsored sport.
- Applicant must hold a minimum GPA of 3.0.
- Applicant must furnish a copy of high school transcript.
- Applicant must be attending a college, business, career, or trade school in the Fall following graduation as a full-time student.
- Applicant must submit a fully completed application, including a personal essay (see explanation below).

Directions for the Applicant

Note: The application is to be completed by the student, not a parent or other third party.

1. Review the eligibility requirements (above).
2. Complete the application packet in full, including personal essay.
3. Submit all components by the published deadline (no late entries). Deadline is March 1, 2024

Personal Essay

The applicant must submit a well-written, personal essay in which he/she addresses the following:

- Explain how your character and actions personify the qualities of character (detailed above) that defined the life of Justin Demary. Use examples and personal experiences to demonstrate these qualities.

The essay should be typed with double spacing and a minimum of one full page but no more than three pages. 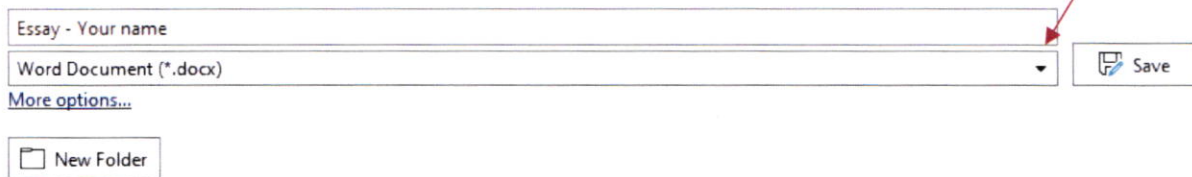
Instructions For Submitting Your Application:

Applications can be submitted in the following ways:

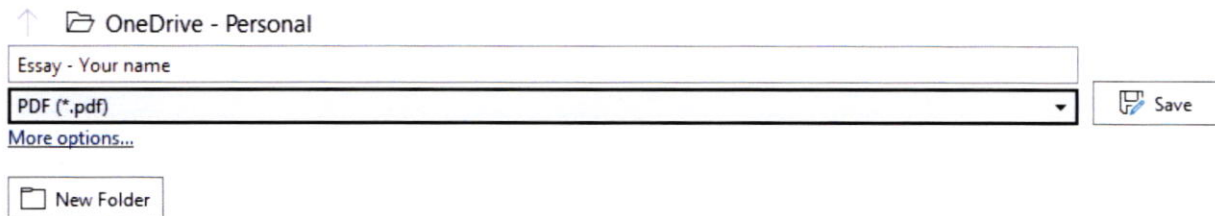
- 1) Via Mail – You can mail your application and all your supporting documentation to: The Justin Demary Foundation for Impacting Athletics, 1754 Ardoin Rd, Iowa, LA 70647. The application deadline is March 1, 2024. All applications must be postmarked by this deadline.
- 2) Via Our Website – You can go to our website www.jd6foundation.org and submit your application and all your supporting documentation. Essay MUST BE in word or pdf format. DO NOT UPLOAD A PICTURE OF YOUR ESSAY. All other documentation (ie. application, copy of transcript) can be pdf, jpeg, or png.

Scanning documents using iPhone

- Open the Notes app
