Here We Grow!

Greetings,

We are very happy to report continued growth for both the district (2.2 points-solid B) and 40 of our 57 schools. Our D/F schools dropped from 16 to 14, while our A/B schools went up to 31 from 26.

88% of our students attend A, B, or C schools, a very good number for a large district like Calcasieu.

All 57 of our schools received a C or better in the State's Progress calculation, with 28 getting an "A" and 26 earning a 'B'.

We are steadily seeing growth within our zone schools. I'm happy to announce that after the first year of transformation within the "Zone Schools," eight of the 12 schools have shown improvement with Washington Marion leading the way (+14.9); Brentwood (+8.8); Pearl Watson (+5.4); LaGrange (+5.2); and Fairview Elementary (+4.1). There are three school that were .3 - 1.4 points away, four school that are 10 points away, and three schools that are between 13-17 points away from being a C. John J. Johnson & J.D. Clifton assume the grades of their feeder schools. However, the Louisiana Department of Education is piloting assessments for K-2 school. Our goal is for each school to be at a C in 2021- 2022.

We're excited as 100% of our principals returned and over 85% of the teachers returned to the zone school. This creates stability as there's a clear understanding of the curriculum and the new teacher and school support system that have been established. We have a great way to go, but wanted to commend the principals, teachers, students, and staff for their handwork and dedication. Finally, congratulations to Washington Marion for obtaining a letter grade of a B which is the first time since letter grades were established. ~ Marcus Jackson, Ed.D
