- A. Advisory Committee Overview (Responsibilities) Dr. Marcus Jackson & Mack Delafosse
 - **Approving ambitious, attainable goals for Zone schools** and ensuring that stakeholders within the district and the broader community are aware of these goals. These goals should focus on metrics including student academic achievement, high school graduation rates and college and career readiness, and full staffing of schools with effective teachers and leaders.
 - **Monitoring progress toward the goals** by reviewing data and getting updates from the Zone leader. They should also use the data gathered to inform goals for the next school year. In order to monitor progress, the advisory committee will look at the on: academic outcomes and Leap 360 data at Zone schools; high school completion and credential attainment; high school on track indicators and credential programs; and staffing and vacancies at Zone schools.
 - **Elevating the Zone's success and illuminating its challenges** through public advisory committee meetings. These efforts will help ensure supportive and clear-eyed community assessment of the broader progress of the Zone and examination of its functioning within the broader district context.
 - **In addition to the responsibilities above, the chairperson of the committee will serve as the lead steward of the Zone strategy who is able to engage with other committee members, district staff, and external stakeholders to explain the progress of Zone schools and build shared commitment for the Zone's**

mission and strategy. Additionally, the chairperson and Zone leader should work together to execute the committee's key responsibilities and to minimize additional requests.

C. Louisiana's Accountability System

- What is Louisiana's Accountability System?
 - The Louisiana's accountability system was developed to inform and focus educators through clear expectations for student outcomes: and provide objective information about school quality to parents and other community stakeholders.
 - Annually, public schools in Louisiana receive a School Performance Score (SPS) and corresponding letter grade that measures how well they are preparing all of their students for the next grade level or postsecondary education.
