The R3 Zone Advisory Committee Meeting was held in the Superintendents Conference Room at the Central Office, located at 3310 Broad St, Lake Charles, Louisiana, 70615, on Monday, September 16, 2019, at 6:00 pm.

B. Status of Goals for 18-19 School Year- Dr. Jackson

1. By the end of the third year of the Redesign Grant, the SPS of each zone school rated F will grow a minimum of 16 points from their projected 2018 SPS and D rated schools will grow a minimum of 12 points. **Grew 3.0 points**
2. The percent of students scoring mastery or above on State standardized assessments will increase at levels over three years of the grant.
  - The number of zone students in grades 3-8 achieving Mastery on LEAP Assessments will increase by at least 3% each year of the Redesign Grant. **Increased 2.8%**
  - High School zone students achieving Mastery on EOC Assessments will increase from 12% in 2017 to a minimum of 24% in 2021. **Increased 3%**
  - The combined ACT and Work Keys index of each zone high school will increase by at least 3 points each school year. **1.8 points ACT and Work Keys Scores**
3. Within three years, K-2 schools will increase their DIBELS Composite % Core and decrease their % of Intensive students to the district average. Yearly targets will be set using recent trend data.
4. At the end of each year 90% of K-2 students will meet their SLT Goal assessed by DCA's. **86%**
5. By 2021 Cohort Graduation Rate at zone high schools will increase.
  - Washington Marion High School: 61.6% to 70%. **Currently at 76.1**
  - LaGrange High School: 74% to 78%. **Currently at 75%**
6. Each zone school will earn composite scores on the Qualitative Indicators of their end of the year TAP School Review Summary Report Conducted by NIET.
  - 2019-19 school year 3.0 or higher – **3.2**
  - 2019-20 school year 3.5 or higher
  - 2020-21 school year 4.0 or higher

7. At the beginning of each school year, 90% or more of teachers in zone schools will be certified in the area in which they teach. **Increased 87%**
8. Attendance Goals: Teachers 90%, Students 93%/ **Goal achieved 88% Teachers, 90% Students**
9. Zone schools will score 90% or higher each year on the SWPBIS Tiered Fidelity Instrument. **Met 90% Target**
10. Principals at each zone school will earn a rating of 3.5 or higher by their faculty members on the McRel Leadership Responsibilities Survey. **Averaged 3.4**
