The basic requirements are as follows:

1. Must be 14 years or under by January 1 of the club year application is made.
2. Must have at least two (2) years of 4-H club work, including award year.
3. Must score at least 250 points on the application scorecard.
4. This award can only be won by the 4-H member one time.
5. **Parish deadline for submission is Friday, January 29<sup>TH</sup>**

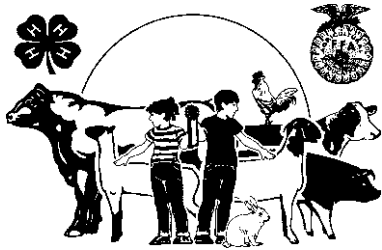
### **4-H Emerald Achievement Award**

The basic requirements are as follows:

1. Must be 15 years of age (or older) by January 1 of the year application is made.
2. Must have three years of 4-H club work, including award year.
3. Must have completed one year of active Junior Leadership work excluding award year.
4. Must score at least 360 points on the application and scorecard.
5. A club member can only win this award one time
6. **Parish deadline for submission is Friday, January 29TH**

- 8:00 AM Chicken and Rabbit Check in begins
- 10:00 AM Chicken and Rabbit Show
- 4:00 PM- 7:00 PM Goats & Sheep may arrive
- Check in and weigh Market Goats/Breeding Goats, mouth Commercial Does
- 5 PM- 6PM Goat premier exhibitor

### **Wednesday, January 20**

- 9:00 AM Goat Show: Goat showmanship followed by Breeding, Commercial Does, then Market. Animals to be released after show.
- 5:00 PM- 7:00 PM Sheep May Arrive
- Check in and weigh Market Lambs/Breeding Sheep, mouth Commercial Ewes
- 5:00 PM- 6:00 PM Lamb premier exhibitor

### **Thursday, January 21**

- 9:00 AM Lamb showmanship followed by Breeding, Commercial Ewes, then Market. Animals to be released after show
- 4:00 PM- 7:00 PM Cattle can enter barn
- 5:00 PM- 7:00 PM Steer and Commercial Heifers/Dairy Weigh in. Steer Hair Check.
- 5:00 PM- 7:00 PM Cattle premier exhibitor

### **Friday, January 22**

- 8:00 AM Beef Showmanship then Beef Breeding, Commercial Heifers, Steers. Cattle released after the show.
- 9:00 AM Dairy Show: Showmanship, Breeding followed by Commercial. Released after the show.
- 6:00 PM- 10:00 PM Gates open for swine. All pigs must be in the barn by 10 PM.

### **Saturday, January 23**

- 7:00 AM- 11:00 AM Weigh market hogs and classify.
- 9:00 AM- 11:00 AM Swine premier exhibitor
- 12:30 PM Swine showmanship followed immediately by Breeding swine show.

### **Sunday, January 24**

- 9:00 AM Swine market show All swine will be released at the conclusion of the show.

## LOUISIANA BEEF INDUSTRY COUNCIL BEEF POSTER CONTEST

With the holiday season upon us and COVID-19 numbers increasing, do not forget about the beef poster contest. This contest is creative, easy educational programming for youth to complete at home during the holiday season.

The beef poster contest encourages participants to learn more about the beef industry, meat science, and nutrition while developing marketing, communication, organization, and research skills.

Participants will compete against all other entries regardless of age.

### 2021 LBIC Beef Poster Contest Theme:

## GREEN BEEF

The theme surrounds the concept that the consumption of beef is safe and vital for the environment. Remember, the poster contest is about marketing and communicating the all-around (environmental, health, nutrition, economic, etc.) benefits of beef.

### Guidelines:

The Louisiana Beef Industry Council Beef Poster Contest will be due to the Calcasieu 4-H Office by **March 1, 2021**. Posters will be judged with winners announced after judging. Winners will qualify for the State Contest in April.

1. Posters must be on "**22 x 28" poster board only**."
2. Place your **NAME, ADDRESS, AGE, GRADE IN SCHOOL AND PARISH/CHAPTER** on back, upper right corner of poster.
3. Posters designs should generate positive images and promotion of beef (not live cattle production) **using the indicated theme**. Posters should promote beef without projecting any negative messages towards other agricultural commodities (chicken, pork, etc.).

**DO NOT use copyrighted materials** • You may develop ideas from magazines, parents, friends,

nutrition bulletins, Beef Ambassador Fact Sheets and meat publications but the end concept should be original and not copied material.

Materials to pull ideas from are also available from your local supermarket, butcher, the American Meat Institute and National Livestock and Meat Board.

### AWARDS

- **First Place** – State winning posters in each division will receive \$200 sponsored by the Louisiana Beef Industry Council
- **Second Place** – State winning posters in each division will receive \$100 sponsored by the Louisiana Beef Industry Council
- **Third Place** – State winning posters in each division will receive \$50 check sponsored by the Louisiana Beef Industry Council
