Some great activities that parents can do at home that doesn't involve screen time include:

- Reading a book and asking questions
- A scavenger hunt in the house
 - * Can you find things in our house that have numbers on them (ex: clock, microwave, telephone)
 - *What is something in our house that we use to measure something (AC, ruler, thermometer, measuring cup, scale)
 - *Find some things in our house that turn on and off
 - *Find everything in our house that is soft
 - *Find items with letters or words written on them
- Practice spelling and writing first and last names
- Practice counting pennies
- Practice cutting with scissors or using clothespins to pick up tissue (fine motor)
- Create a family logo and flag
- Sorting laundry into colors, whites, and reds
- Practice putting words together for example, *what do you get when you put foot and ball together ?* (football) high and chair /highchair drive and way /drive way
- Practice rhyming words funny, money, honey cat, hat, mat, sat sink, wink, think Wing, thing, king, sing red, bed, head
- Draw a map of your house
- Sing songs and nursery rhymes (alphabet, 5 little monkeys, wheels on the bus)
