## **DMS Cheerleader Constitution**

## 2021-2022

#### 1. Tryout Requirements

- **a.** Each member must maintain a 2.4 average
- **b.** Each member must turn in a completed Tryout Agreement/Permission Form and a Tryout Application by **April 14, 2021 @ 3:30 pm.**
- **c.** Each member must submit a signed Constitution Agreement Slip by **April 16, 2021 @ 3:30 pm** by parents permitting the following:
  - i. Compliance with all rules and regulations set forth by the De Quincy Middle School Administration, Calcasieu Parish School District, and the Cheerleading Sponsor(s).
  - **ii.** Participation guaranteeing financial responsibility of ALL monetary requirements and participation.
- **d.** Any ISI or suspension of a prospective member will be evaluated by the administration and sponsor(s) and may result in not being able to participate in tryouts.
- e. Any cheerleader that has been dismissed or quit the squad the previous year will not be eligible to try out the next year (exception to this is if a cheerleader moves during the season)
- f. All prospective members <u>must be in attendance at school the day of tryouts and must tryout in</u> their "self-drawn" numerical order.

#### 2. Organization

- **a.** This constitution has been written and adopted for the DMS Cheerleader Origination. The squad and its Constitution are governed by the De Quincy Middle School Cheer Sponsor(s) and school administrators.
- **b.** The purpose of the De Quincy Middle School Cheerleaders is to:
  - i. Create school spirit, pride, and loyalty.
  - ii. Promote interest in school activities and perform at school games.
  - **iii.** Develop responsibility, teach self-respect, encourage honesty, effort, strive for excellence, and develop character.
  - **iv.** Teach teamwork and pride in a quality performance through maintaining high standards.
- **c.** The sponsor(s) will be responsible for the daily running and activities of the De Quincy Middle School Cheerleaders
  - i. The sponsor(s) will be responsible for administering merits and/or demerits.
  - ii. The sponsor(s) may place certain restrictions on squad members.

#### 3. Squad Membership requirements

- **a.** The squad will be composed of sixth, seventh and eighth grade students.
- b. The head cheerleaders (if needed) will be selected by sponsors
- **c.** Must be responsible for all cheer uniforms, camp/practice clothes and equipment.
- **d.** Must attend summer camp at the beginning of June at McNeese State University.
- e. Members must maintain a 2.4 average each semester.
  - i. Any member who has D's or F's will have consequences per demerit sheet
- **f.** Any situation resulting in lunch detention, ISI/ISD or suspension of a member will have consequences per the demerit sheet.
- g. Each member Must attend all practices, meetings, games, and designated activities.

#### 4. Parent requirments

- a. Support, reinforce and abide by cheerleader constitution rules
- b. If any problems arise in the year (with sponsors, or other cheerleaders/parents) schedule an appointment to discuss with the sponsors.
- c. Provide their cheerleader with rides, and pick up at the assigned times
- d. Provide financial support to their cheerleader
- **e.** Understand that while your cheerleader is under our watch, she will be instructed not to leave the game/practice/camp area until we dismiss or allow them to leave the area
- f. Parents will not have any altercations/post with phone use: social media, text or calls about cheer or other cheerleaders, sponsors, administration, students or adults! <u>It is very important</u> that we, the adults, are role models for our children.

#### 5. ATTENDANCE

Each cheerleader is required to participate in all cheerleading activities such as practices, summer camp, games, fundraisers, etc. If you cannot attend a function the sponsor must be notified ahead of time for approval.

- **a.** All members must be in attendance at least the afternoon ½ day of school in order to cheer at a scheduled event.
- **b.** To participate in a practice, a member must attend school 7<sup>th</sup> hour.
- **c.** All practices and meetings are necessary for a good cheerleading squad. <u>Remember, whenever</u> you are not present, most formations, pyramids, routines, and stunts cannot be practiced. You are therefore, hurting the entire squad.
- **d.** Attendance at practice before a pep rally or game is mandatory or the cheerleader will be benched. Excused or unexcused
- **e.** Cheerleaders are required to wear athletic shorts (no uniform shorts), t-shirt and cheer shoes to practice
- **f.** A cheerleader is expected to participate fully in all P.E. activities and dressing out. P.E. helps to condition the body, keep it flexible, and build endurance.
- g. Attendance records will be kept. Three tardies will be considered one unexcused absence.
- h. When absent from school or checking out, it is the cheerleaders (or parents) responsibility to notify the sponsor/sponsors. Sending a message by another cheerleader is NOT acceptable!!
- i. Any unexcused absence will result in demerits according to the demerit sheet.
- **j.** Absences for the following reasons will be excused:
  - i. Doctor's appointment w/ excuse
  - ii. Death in the family
  - iii. School function
  - iv. Emergencies at sponsor's discretion
- k. If a member misses a practice before a performance, the member will not perform.
  - **i.** An absence must be documented by the parent in writing or a phone call at least the morning of an event with the sponsors in advance.
  - **ii.** All doctor's appointments, etc., should be scheduled so they do not interfere with squad practices and activities.
- I. All members must attend each activity in its entirety.
- m. In case of <u>minor</u> illness, injury, and probation (academic/disciplinary), a member will be required to attend all practices and games and dress out.

## 6. CONDUCT

- **a.** Certain standards are necessary for the integrity and reputation of any organization that is charged with leadership and responsibilities both at school and in the public.
- **b.** They will display good sportsmanship at all times, cheerleaders should never insult the opponent team or any other representative of a school or referee.
- **c.** De Quincy Middle School believes that cheerleaders should be leaders and set good examples at all times both in school and in the community (whether in uniform or out).
- **d.** Cheerleaders will be dismissed from the squad if suspended from school
- e. Cheerleaders must not have any altercations/post with written or phone use: social media, text, calls about cheer or other cheerleaders, students or adults. THIS APPLIES TO PARENTS AS WELL, IF SO THE CHEERLEADER WIL HAVE THE CONSEQUENCES.
- f. Members are expected to maintain character above reproach. Smoking, drinking, use of drugs, inappropriate language or behavior, poor sportsmanship, confrontations, unbecoming behavior in the classroom, extreme display of undesirable emotions or tantrums, or public display of affection will not be allowed.
- g. Any moral or ethical violations will be reviewed by the administration and/or sponsor and dealt with on an individual basis. A severe clause will be applied if warranted.

#### 7. PRACTICE CONDUCT

- **a.** Must attend all practices-any extenuating circumstances must be discussed with the sponsor in advance (practices held approximately 1-2 days a week).
- b. <u>Members must inform sponsor if they are checking out of school and will not be attending practice or missing practice for any reason.</u>
- **c.** At no time should members be standing around not working. Not attempting to work at practice is grounds for a demerit.
- **d.** Chronic tardiness, either getting to practice or being picked up, will result in demerits.
- e. No gum or food (except water) is allowed at practice.

#### 8. GAME CONDUCT

- **a.** Must attend all games and activities assigned by sponsor.
- **b.** YOU ARE NOT ALLOWED TO STAY AFTER SCHOOL UNLESS A PRACTICE IS ASSIGNED. This is for safety reasons.
- **c.** Cheerleaders must report to the field or gym 30 minutes before game time to warm up properly and be formation 5 minutes before the beginning of the game.
- **d.** Cheerleaders must stand in formation at all times during the game.
- e. Must be dressed in proper uniform with NO JEWELRY (studs only).
- f. Nails must be an appropriate length
- **g.** A break will be taken at half time prior to going to the visitor side.
- **h.** Each cheerleader is responsible for all "props" at the game
- i. The head cheerleaders are the leaders—everyone must follow their direction at games.
- j. No gum, food or drinks are allowed while cheering.
- **k.** At no time should you be visiting with anyone from the crowd.
- **I.** Any squad member not cheering will be made to leave the cheering area and sit in the stands with the sponsor.
- **m.** All members should be back to the designated cheering area ready to cheer at the designated time.

- **n.** Good sportsmanship is very important. At no time will a member be rude or discourteous to another school.
- **o.** Football games are Tuesdays at 5:30. Basketball games are Mondays and Thursdays at 5:00. You must be at the gym at the time assigned by your sponsor. (The days and times could change)
- p. All cheerleaders will be required to stay on the field after each game to meet with the sponsors and to pick up all "props" We will then walk as a squad to the gym and put away the "props". The cheerleaders will be released to their parents from there. If it is an away game the cheerleaders will walk to the sponsors vehicle to put away the props and be released from there.

#### 9. UNIFORMS

- **a.** Each member will be expected to provide clothes and cheer uniforms. The costs of these are the complete responsibility of each member.
- **b.** Socks and accessories such as hair bows will be purchased by each member.
- **c.** Members will be required to wear the designated practice clothes and/or cheer uniform as instructed by the sponsor.
- **d.** Any part of the cheer uniform or practice/camp clothes lost, stolen, and/or damaged must be replaced and/or paid for by the member.
- e. Cheerleaders should not allow other students to wear cheer clothes or uniforms.

#### 10. Safety

- **a.** Never build any pyramid without one of the sponsors present.
- **b.** Stretch and warm up thoroughly before any practice or performance
- c. Absolute silence is required when building pyramids. (complete concentration is necessary)
- d. Always keep your heads up, mouths closed, and hands up when spotting on all pyramids
- e. Evaluate the safety conditions of all areas before performing.

## 11. PAYMENT

- **a.** Payment schedule:
  - i. The total payment will be broken into three separate payments.
  - **ii.** If fees are not paid by <u>due dates</u>, contact will be made with parent/guardian to request payment.
  - **iii.** If **ALL** money is not paid by the end of the school year, member will not be allowed to attend camp and will not be a Cheerleader at DMS.

#### 12. FUNDRAISERS

**a.** We will have a fundraiser in order to raise money for any new cheerleading equipment needed. All members must participate and raise money.

## 13. ACTIVITIES

- **a.** All home games including football, and basketball.
- **b.** Most away games
- c. Summer cheer camp-
- d. Fundraisers
- e. Pep-rallies
- **f.** Other activities at the discretion of the sponsor.

#### 14. DISCIPLINE POLICY

- a. Cheerleaders will receive merits and demerits for positive and negative rule violations.
- **b.** Cheerleaders may be benched (quarters, halves, or for entire games)
- c. Consequences

- i. <u>Level 1</u>....5 demerits will result in one-week probation in which the member will be required to attend all practices but will be benched for any game. Member must dress out if benched.
- **ii.** <u>Level 2</u>....7 demerits will result in two weeks probation in which the member will be required to attend all practices but will be benched for any game. Member must dress out if benched.
- iii. Level 2.....10 demerits will result in dismissal from the squad.

## 15. MISCELLANEOUS

- **a.** The rules and by-laws will be ruled upon by the sponsor(s) and/or administration. All decisions made by the sponsor(s) and/or administration are final.
- **b.** Members must abide by these laws, De Quincy Middle School Policies, and the policies of Calcasieu Parish School Board.
- **c.** Violation of these rules may lead to temporary or permanent suspension from the squad.
- **d.** All by-laws apply during summer.
- **e.** The sponsor(s) and/or administration will handle and situation not described in this constitution as they deem appropriate and necessary.
