

How do I get updates on the I-210 repair project?

DOTD has several ways to follow construction and roadway activity and conditions right from your computer, smartphone, or tablet.

MYDOTD

This is a web portal that allows you to view and receive scheduled lane closures, press releases, and public meeting notices via email. The site is broken down by district and parish. You can create an account and receive information by parish, multiple parishes, regions, or the entire state. You can also simply visit the site and bookmark pages that you can view each day. In short, you get the information the moment we send it out to the media.

Click the sign up button, and create an account.

This traffic website and app works just like Google. You can check out the entire state and view traffic cameras, check up on construction, see traffic issues and conditions, and more. You can also create your own route and have alerts sent to your phone via email or text.

Click the register button in the top right corner, and create an account.

You can customize your alerts to this project by selecting “My511” then “My Routes & Alerts” and clicking “Create Area Alert”.

Draw a shape around the project area and fill in the appropriate boxes. The alerts can be delivered by text message or email.

You can also access [511 via mobile app](#). You can download the app from the App Store or Google Play Store.
