Remind

Check with your child's teacher to receive the access code information for the classroom Remind.

- Please remember that students must be signed-in by an adult (parent or guardian) when they are tardy to school in the mornings. After our 7:50 AM tardy bell, all staff members must go inside the building to start our instructional day so it is an unsafe practice for students to be dropped off in the front circle drive and no adult ensures that they make it safely into the building to be received in the office by office staff.
- Our dismissal bell rings at 2:55 PM. Through your collaborative efforts and support of the dismissal process, we have gotten it down to a science. By 3:15 PM, all students have been picked up either by car/bus and all walkers escorted to the designated crossing points.
