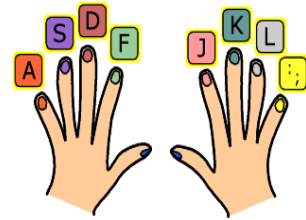


Intro to Business and Computer Applications (IBCA)
