## Grading...

IXL will be both an in-class and homework assignment, depending on how well you use your class time. We will have time each week to work on it during RTI, but if you do not use your time



well you will not finish. To get full credit, you need to have a SMART Score of 80% or above. Each 100% earns you a gold star on the chart and a space on the 100 Chart Lottery. You can repeat each assignment as many times as needed to improve your score and can work on it at home (as you would homework). To access IXL, go through Launchpad and it automatically signs you in. The only IXL Assignments that count towards your grade are the Teacher Suggested Skills. The list is found in the upper right-hand corner of your screen. As we progress through our curriculum there will be new skills posted that match the lessons we are currently working on. If you get behind - it is best to start on the new assignments first because those match the lessons we are working and will help you the most with your classwork. The Progress/Star Chart will be updated every week and we will add your 100% to the Hundred Chart Lottery. Each week, the highest scoring students (out of all the classes) earn the IXL Jedi Masters award - you get to choose a bag of candy. The highest scoring students at the end of each 9 weeks period earn a spot in the IXL Hall of Fame. Hall of Fame prizes include a medal and other treats .
