The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) must be completed to receive TOPS or TOPS Tech.

- 1. The student and one parent will each need a FSA ID username & password.
- 2. Items needed to create your FSA ID: Social Security Number & Name (as printed on your SS Card), personal email address, cell phone number.
- 3. Create your student and Parent FSA ID Username & Password at <u>WWW.STUDENTAID.GOV</u>
 - a. Student and parent cannot use the same email address or cell phone number.
 - b. Students should not use their school email.
- 4. It is important to verify your email address and cell phone number.
- 5. Your FSA ID will be needed annually for FAFSA/TOPS/TOPS Tech renewal.
- 6. Store a photo of your completed worksheet on your phone for easy access.
