PK - 5th students all start on August 24th. All School Supply Lists are located on our school website.

STUDENT INFORMATION PACKET PICK UP

Packets will be available for pick up on Friday, August 7th at 9:00 in the front of the school. Packets will be in tubs on the benches. All packets will be the same. Please complete packets & return them at the Back to School Curbside Kickoff (August 18th) or the 1st Day of School (August 24th). Please be sure to complete & return the packets so that we know how students are getting home on the 1st Day of School.

BACK TO SCHOOL CURBSIDE KICKOFF

Mark your calendars for August 18th from 9 - 12. Each grade level will be set up with a table at the Henry Heights Recreation Center for you to drive up to so that you can meet your child's teacher & drop off supplies, please have supplies labeled with their name.

VISITORS

No visitors are allowed on campus without an appointment. If you need to come to the front office, you will have to call 217 - 4620 for someone to come meet you at the front door or at your car. If you do come into the school, your temperature will be checked & you will be required to wear a mask.

BREAKFAST & LUNCH

All students receive FREE Breakfast & Lunch. Both Breakfast & Lunch will be served in classrooms.

WHERE DO I DROP MY STUDENT OFF IN THE MORNINGS?

Students can be dropped off either at the Bus Ramp off of Louisiana Ave. or at the front doors of the school off of Louisisna Ave. Students will report straight to their classrooms.

WATER BOTTLES

All water fountains will be closed. Students are encouraged to bring their own water bottle from home. Please be sure to have your child's name written on the water bottle.



FACE COVERINGS

As stated in the CPSB Return to School Plan, PK - 5th students will be required to wear a face mask during transitions: on the bus & during arrival / dismissal. 3rd - 5th grade must wear a mask at all other times. CPSB will provide 2 masks for each student; however, students may bring their own masks which can have school appropriate designs. Please be sure to label your child's mask with their name.

RECESS & ENRICHMENTS

Students will continue to have Art, Library, & PE as well as go to recess; however, they will stay in their small groups to limit the amount of student contact.

SANITIZING PROCEDURES

We will be following CPSB Return to School Plan for cleaning and sanitizing procedures. This includes, but is not limited to sanitizing stations in each classroom, classrooms being cleaned each day with electrostatic sprayers, and increased cleaning of the bathrooms. Daily temperature checks will be completed on all students and staff each day.

PARENTS ARE ENCOURAGED TO BRING THEIR CHILDREN TO SCHOOL DUE TO THE LIMITED AMOUNT OF SEATS ON THE BUS.

DISMISSAL FOR WALKERS / REC CENTER

If you plan on walking up to meet your child for dismissal, please wait at the double doors on E. School St. Walkers will be assisted to cross the street (E. School / Louisiana Ave.)

DISMISSAL FOR CAR & BUS RIDERS

Students can be picked up either at the Bus Ramp off of Louisiana Ave. or at the front doors of the school off of Louisiana Ave.
