

## WHAT CAN I DO ABOUT MY CLASSWORK DURING MY QUARANTINE?

1. Check/log in to Blackboard every day.
2. Complete assignments daily and turn them in.
3. Check your school board email for messages from your teachers as to what you missed in class that day.

Each teacher has class documents that can be printed out for your use.

What if I don't have internet access?

1. Go to a public place that has WIFI, sit in the parking lot, and use theirs.
2. Come sit in your car in the school parking lot and use our WIFI.
3. If you are not ill and have no symptoms, go to someone you know who has internet and use theirs. Wear your mask.

What do I do if I don't have a printer or ink?

1. Write your assignments on a piece of paper and complete them.
2. Have someone else print it out for you.
3. Email your teacher to send a copy down to the office and have your parent schedule a pickup time.

How do I turn in my assignments?

1. Email your assignment as an attachment to your teacher.
2. Take a picture of your assignment and email it to your teacher.
3. Have someone bring completed assignments to school to turn in. DO NOT wait until you return to turn in all assignments.

Just because you are under quarantine does not mean that you are exempt from class assignments. If you do not turn them in, you will receive an F for those assignments. Do not wait until you return to try to play "catch up" on everything. It is nearly impossible to complete 2 weeks of work in a small amount of time and your teacher may not have time to grade everything before grades are due.
