- Engineering is Elementary® (EiE®) is a project of the National Center for Technological Literacy® at the Museum of Science, Boston.
- Provides cross-curricular integration of Science, Math and Social Studies.
- EiE has Life Science, Physical Science and Earth & Space Science correlations.
- Each module lasts 7-9 weeks.
- Teachers receive a \$500 stipend per module.
- Material kits cost \$350 - \$400 and consumables replenish for about \$75 after each use.

Program Timeline

August 2015 - McNeese State University agrees to provide teacher training for each module. Expenses for the pilot are dedicated to be paid by The PROGRESS Project and CPSB general funds.

January 2016 –Pilot program begins with 100 4th grade students participating in 6 schools.

August 2016 – 4th & 5th grade programs launch at 20 schools with 500 student participants.

October 2016 – CITGO grants \$50,000 to CPSB to support the EiE program.

January 2017 – The PROGRESS Project and CPSB agree to fund a project expansion. The addition of the 3rd Grade module “Bubble Bonanza” takes student participation over 800.

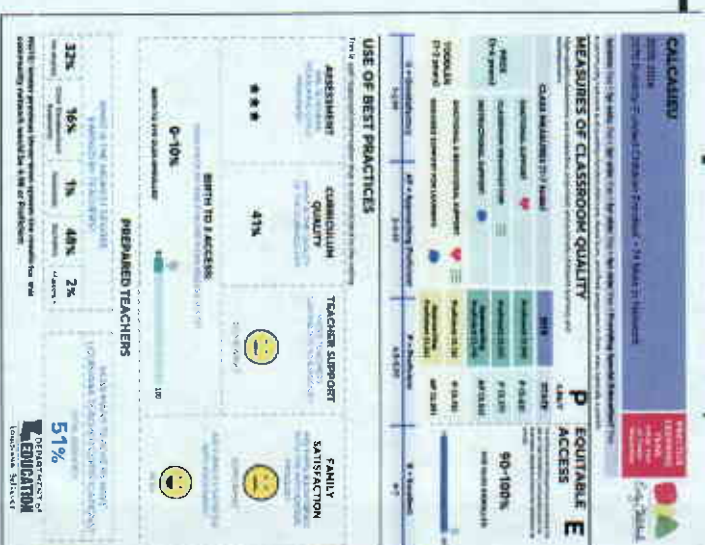

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What Is CLASS?

What Does CLASS Even Mean?

- CLASS stands for **C**lassroom **A**ssessment **S**coring **S**ystem.
- The interactions teachers have with children impact learning, development—even lifelong achievement. CLASS is the observation tool developed to assess these interactions: from infant care through 12th grade. Teachstone is committed to delivering on the promise of CLASS.

Where Did CLASS Come From?

- The story of CLASS begins in the 1990s at the University of Virginia's Curry School of Education where researchers were studying factors of early childhood development.
- They learned that interactions impacted child outcomes and that such interactions could be objectively measured.
- Looking at interactions rather than environmental factors was a new school of thought, but it took off quickly. Soon CLASS had been adopted by The Federal Office of Head Start as a way to measure and improve child outcomes.
- To scale CLASS along with the growing demand, Bob Pianta, PhD, and Bridget Hamre, PhD, founded Teachstone in 2008.

What Is Involved With CLASS Observations?

- CLASS observations are completed by Teachstone-trained CLASS Observers who assign scores to specific teacher behaviors and responses.
- Because children learn differently at each age level, CLASS Observers must be certified for the age level they observe: infant, toddler, pre-k, K-3, upper elementary, or secondary education.

Who Uses CLASS Today?

- The focus on effective interactions is growing. CLASS has been adopted by programs all over the world, helping millions of children succeed in the classroom—and beyond.
- Research has shown that to deliver on the promise of CLASS, organizations need to couple observations with professional development. That's why today many organizations and states use CLASS as a part of their professional development programs.

Eligibility criteria apply providing guidelines are met. By law, Calcasieu Parish School Board Head Start must provide services to families with a family income at or below the Federal poverty guidelines.

NOTE: In August 2017, parents will be asked to provide documentation of his/her child's completed physical along with his/her current immunization and dental exam. Student's acceptance will be contingent upon receiving these documents.

Rational for Changing Virtual School Providers

For some time now C&I staff members have been concerned with the degree of alignment our current virtual program has with our Jump Start Career Pathways. For this reason we began searching to see if there were other providers available who were better aligned to the unique requirements of Louisiana's Jump Start Program. As we searched we found that a company called Odysseyware had partnered with several Louisiana districts to design virtual courses specifically to meet the requirements of Jump Start. Since then we invited over 60 educators from each of the departments in our district that use virtual learning to compare Odysseyware to Edmentum, the current program we use for virtual learning. Below are several of the advantages that these educators listed in the feedback they provided us after a trial period.

- The CTE course offerings are significantly larger and more aligned to our CPSB Career Pathways and the Louisiana State Standards.
- Odysseyware uses a single platform for student and teacher access.
- The program's Credit Recovery Mode allows courses to be condensed depending on a student's score on a diagnostic pre-test.
- All components of the Odysseyware program are included in one price and the district will not have to pay extra to purchase additional services as we do currently.
- Courses in Odysseyware are tiered to match the appropriate rigor to the wide variety of students using the program across our district.
- Courses are provided for more grade levels than our current provider.
- Odysseyware will customize the courses offered to meet any unique needs CPSB or the State may have without burdening the teachers to do the work.
- The Odysseyware program is accredited by the NCAA
- Odysseyware has well defined support services and a detailed action plan for professional development and implementation.
- 20 districts in Louisiana are currently using Odysseyware with at least four other districts switching to Odysseyware next school year.
- There will be a very significant cost savings by switching to Odysseyware.

After careful review, it is our recommendation to the C&I Committee that we enter into a three year contract with Odysseyware, totaling \$272,250, to provide online learning services to the students of Calcasieu Parish.
