Building Foundations for the Future

District Calendar Committee Guidelines

Required by law or policy:

- 1. Calendars must contain 182 teacher work days.
- 2. Bulletin 741 requires that a minimum of 63,720 instructional minutes be provided to students each school year. The number of school days and the length of each day is left up to each individual LEA as long as the 63,720-minute requirement is met.
- 3. The fall semester must end on the last day of school in December for personnel and LHSAA reasons.

Things that are taken into consideration:

- The number of instructional days required to be scheduled in the calendar is driven by
 the school in the district with the lowest number of instructional minutes in their school
 day. CPSB requires that schools schedule at least 380 instructional minutes each day.
 That number is used to decide the number of instructional days needed in our calendar.
- 2. Each year we build 3-4 emergency days into our calendar to offset minutes that are missed as a result of things such as weather, loss of power or water, major equipment failures, homecoming activities, athletic events, and festivals.
- 3. The difference between instructional days and the required 182 teacher work days usually allows for nine days to be scheduled for professional development. In recent years we have frontloaded the majority of this PD prior to school starting. This allows our teachers to begin the school year with valuable information and training that they and their students can benefit from the whole school year and prevents us from breaking up more instructional weeks throughout the school year.

Traditionally:

- From feedback we have received, we do our best to carve out the 182 teacher work days by starting no earlier than the second week in August and ending prior to Memorial Day in May.
- 2. The last instructional day has always been a half day for students.
- 3. We have traditionally observed Labor Day, Veterans' Day, MLK Day, Mardi Gras, Election Day, Thanksgiving, Christmas, and a Spring Break that is tied to Good Friday and Easter.
- 4. Normally the District Calendar is adopted by the Board at their February Board Meeting.
