#### The 4-H Golden Clover Award:

The basic requirements are as follows:

- 1. Must be 14 years or under by January 1 of the club year application is made.
- 2. Must have at least two (2) years of 4-H club work, including award year.
- 3. Must score at least 250 points on the application scorecard.
- 4. This award can only be won by the 4-H member one time.
- 5. Parish deadline for submission is Friday, January 31st

### **4-H Emerald Achievement Award**

The basic requirements are as follows:

- Must be 15 years of age (or older) by January 1 of the year application is made.
- 2. Must have three years of 4-H club work, including award year.
- Must have completed one year of active Junior Leadership work excluding award year.
- 4. Must score at least 360 points on the application and scorecard.
- 5. A club member can only win this award one time
- 6. <u>Parish deadline for submission is</u> Friday, January 31st

#### **Junior Calf Scramble**

Participants in the Junior Calf Scramble must have reached their 9th, but not their 12th birthday on January 1 of the year they will participate.

# All participants must meet the following general guidelines:

a) must have suitable facilities to care for and develop animals won in the scramble

b must have the emotional maturity and desire to care for an animal


c) must be able to display some reasonable assurance that the participant will show any animal won at the next Southwest District Livestock Show
