Dismissal Routines

Please read the guidelines for dismissal below. **Chief Coates** of the Sulphur Police Department has asked that we inform our parents of proper dismissal procedures.

1. Prek dismissal is at 2:30. Parents of students that are car riders are to come up _Pinecrest St. and turn left onto E. Burton and turn left into the car rider line for Prek students. Please do not turn into the school from E. Burton when heading west. This will lead to congestion at the 4 way stop. Parents of Prek students that have older siblings that are car riders are now able to pick up in the older student car line.

2. Dismissal for grades K-5 is 3:00. The gate will open at 2:30 pm. Cars are to come in from Pinecrest St., make the block on the back of the school, and come up Sherwood. Please do not park on Lewis Street to wait for the gate to open. Park on Sherwood. Do not block any driveways, mailboxes, or the painted sidewalk on Sherwood. The gates will lock at 3:25.
