According to NATIONAL BETA, the following are examples of UNACCEPTABLE items:

- Babysitting
- Any activity performed solely on behalf of another organization (i.e. Scouts, Key Club, 4-H, Student Council, Spanish Club, etc.)

A responsible adult at the residence or business MUST sign and provide a phone # for verification of service.
