## Performances

All band students are required to participate in concerts. These performances can be up to $20 \%$ of their nine weeks grade. Students are to arrive at the announced time (at least 30 minutes) prior to the concert in time for warm-up. There will be notice provided in advance concerning performance dates.

- Beginning Band students are required to perform in the MBMS Band Christmas and Spring Concerts. They are highly encouraged to perform in the LMEA Solo and Ensemble festival held in the spring.
- $7^{\text {th }}$ Grade Band students are required to perform in the MBMS Band Christmas and Spring Concerts, and LMEA Assessment. They are highly encouraged to audition for Honor Band, and to perform in the LMEA Solo and Ensemble festival held in the spring.
- $8^{\text {th }} \mathbf{G r a d e}$ Band are required to perform in the Veteran's Day Program, MBMS Band Christmas and Spring Concerts, and LMEA Assessment. They are highly encouraged to audition for Honor Band, and to perform in the LMEA Solo and Ensemble festival held in the spring.


## Uniform for Performances

## Christmas and Spring Concerts

- Black bottoms, Band Shirt, and clean dark shoes.


## Pep Rallies and Football games

- Band shirt with school khakis or jeans.


## Veteran's Day Program

- $8^{\text {th }}$ Grade Band: Black bottoms and Band Shirt.


## Band Festival(s)

- $7^{\text {th }} \& 8^{\text {th }}$ Grade - Black bottoms and Band Shirt


## Honor Band try-outs / Solo \& Ensemble Festival

- Same dress as if it were a free dress day at school. Casual but nice!


## Band Fee

(Pay online)

- Each student will pay a one-time Band Fee of $\$ 20$. This fee will cover:

## MBMS Band Grading Procedure

*Participation and Practice Reports will combine for ONE weekly grade.
$>$ Participation Grade: Each student will receive 20 points for each class period. This will be totaled at the end of the week for a letter grade. Points will be deducted from the daily grade for the following:

- Band Hall rule violation
- Lack of participation
- No instrument, music, folder, or other materials needed for band
- Rehearsal and/or class disruption
- Unexcused absence
$>$ Practice Report Grade: Practice reports are due on Monday and each student will determine their practice grade as follows:
$120+$ minutes $=\mathrm{A}, 105-119$ minutes $=\mathrm{B}, 84-104$ minutes $=\mathrm{C}, 70-83$ Minutes $=\mathrm{D}$
$>$ Performance Grade: Other grades during the nine weeks will come from the completion of:
- Worksheets
- Playing tests
- Written tests
