


iWish I knew

- What AppleID should I use to sign in to CPSB owned devices?
 - Why use CPSB email?
 - Never use personal AppleID on CPSB owned devices.
- What if I made lots of purchases using a different email?
 - Go to applied.apple.com and manage account to change email address associated with the account
- How do I set up multiple iPads to have the same apps?
 - Restore from backup
 - Automatic downloads – settings/itunes and app stores/apps
- My iPad belonged to a different user and I can't restore it
 - Submit a Tech Help ticket in the Apple section requesting to have the Activation Lock removed.
- My iPad doesn't turn on
 - Try a soft reset
- My iPad says it is up to date but it doesn't have iOS 10
 - Older iPads will only update to iOS 9.3.5 (iPad Mini, 1st gen, iPad 2 and iPad 3rd gen)
 - Devices older than these will only update to iOS 5.1.1
- What's eating my battery?
 - Leaving an App Open - close any app when you will not be using it for a while.
 - Apps Searching for Data - recently used apps aren't completely closed when you press the home button and will continue to utilize resources. Close apps in the multi-tasking tray that you are not using.
 - Searching for a Signal - if your battery is low and you aren't in need of Wi-Fi, Bluetooth, etc. turn on Airplane Mode
 - Checking for Mail – (Settings/Mail, Contacts, Calendars) Under “Fetch New Data”, you can turn “Push” Off and change the “Fetch” settings to check for new mail less often
 - Location Services – (Settings/Location Services) Turn Off unnecessary location services
 - Auto-Lock – (Settings/General) The sooner the iPad is locked, the less battery is used
 - Notifications – (Settings/Notifications) Turn off unnecessary Notifications
 - On an iPhone, the weather and stock widgets running on your notifications will use battery.
 - Low Power Mode (iPhone Only) – If you need to stretch you battery, place device in low power mode
 - When on low power mode, placing your phone face down will prevent your screen from lighting up when alerts come in which will save battery.
- Handy Tools/Tips:
 - Guided Access - settings/general/accessibility/guided access
 - Have text read to you - settings/general/accessibility/speech
 - Magnifying Glass – settings/general/accessibility/magnifier
 - Triple click to turn on
 - Tap icon to the right to enhance it

- Tap shutter to freeze it
- Quick access to the camera
 - Swipe left from the lock screen
- Get Notified when someone replies to an email message
 - Tap the ... More than “notify me”
- Close multiple safari tabs at once
 - Tap and hold the  button
- Search for photos
 - In the photos app, tap the search icon and enter things like, beach, dog, or a specific location, and more
 - You can also use Siri to search for you
- Ask Siri for information
 - She can tell you about sports schedules and stats, she can do math for you, etc.
